TRIP Insurance Reminder (from Tom Lazzaro):

When going on a ski trip, it's not a bad idea to get Insurance for the event. Usually it is for longer trips; 4 days or more. Who knows what will happen after you register and leave for the trip 6-10 months later...will you need insurance to recover the cost of the trip? The club has to cover our cost. We cannot just give money back.

Certainly, you need to purchase Trip Insurance by the appropriate deadline. Refer to your Trip Chairperson or your favorite Trip Insurance company.

ADVICE from a member who had insurance and had to cancel a trip last year:

There are 2 things at minimum you must do:

- 1) If you are canceling due to illness, call your Trip Insurance company **before** you go to the doctor to find out exactly what documentation you will need from the doctor.
- 2) You may need the CLUB cancellation policy for the trip. That is on the GE Ski Club trip application that you signed when registering for the trip. Most likely, you'll have to ask the Trip Chair for a copy if your Insurance company wants to see your **signed** copy. If not, you can download it off our website. Good luck to all!



The Ride for Missing Children Mohawk Valley 2024

Ride History 1997-2024

The beginning - August 18, 1993, a little girl went missing while riding her bike. In searching for her, the family realized she would not be found and they directed their energy to search for all missing children.

In 1995, 7 men road their bicycles from Washington Mills to Washington DC, arriving at the capitol on May 25 National Missing Childrens Day.

After this event, it grew into what it is today "The Ride for Missing Children."

This event is more than just a bike ride. Our Ride raises awareness to help keep children safe. Further, it supports the Cyber Tipline, a national mechanism for the public & electronic services providers to report instances of suspected child sexual exploitation. Since its inception in 1998, the Cyber Tipline has received more than 144 million reports. In 2022, the tip line received 32,059,029.

The information is unbelievable. How can this happen? The sad thing, it does.

MORE INFORMATION

Sadly, this year accommodations for RVs at Green Lakes were filled early in 2023. For those that would like to stay overnight nearby, some state parks with camping are Delta Lake, Verona Beach, and Fair Haven State Park, they all use Reserve America online for booking. RVs can definitely be parked at the East Beach Parking lot which is located right alongside the park's Education Center and boathouse, which would be the ideal place to park for the cookout. Anyone who is not camping here must vacate from the park by sunset which is typically around 9 PM in the summer months. The grassy area right alongside the sanded beach area is for the cookout, They do charge separate park admission from 8 AM -7 PM, it is \$10 per vehicle. I expect we'll enter after 7pm.
